- use a clean rag
- If you're cleaning with a cotton rag, firmly put it over the top of the bottle IPA cleaner tip the bottle over. Allow the alcohol to penetrate the swab or rag for a couple seconds.
- If the alcohol starts to drip on the floor or onto your hand, you've applied too much.
- Make sure you're in a well-ventilated, as alcohol evaporates quickly.
- dampen with Adheseal IPA cleaner.
- Wipe the material down gently and slowly.
- Allow the material to dry.
- Consider blowing or using a cool blow dryer to blow away dust or residual fibres left from a rag.
- Make sure that you're not leaving pools of IPA Cleaner behind you as you clean. If you are, take a clean, dry, white rag and remove any excess
- Once there is no evidence of any residue, application of Adheseal primers, sealants, adhesives and membranes can commence.
